

Language: Fa'hjad

City: Sarhje (pure water)

World: Avani (5th plane)

Description: a very simple and pure 'sacred' language, preserved and spoken by the people of Sarhje for over 2000 years.

Notes: when combining verbs with endings, the last letter of the verb is dropped and the ending is attached as part of the word.

When using two words where the first word ends with a vowel and the second word begins with a vowel, the first letter of the second word is dropped and the two words are combined into one with an apostrophe [i.e. Fa+hjad (or of+mouth) becomes Fa'hjad], unless the first letter is "j", in which case, the "j" is kept when the words are combined and the last letter of the first word is dropped [i.e. Sari+ji (or pure+?) becomes sarji]. This does not apply if one of the words is a proper name.

Names are used more commonly than direct pronouns [e.g. I, you, we, he, she], even when referring to one's own self or while speaking to a person directly [i.e. "Kh'ster mahjeto—Aa Kh'arija ji"]

Body language and non-verbal sounds are used more commonly than speech in order to save water. Whole conversations can take place without a single word said. Additionally, people will often combine words that, linguistically, should not be combined in order to shorten the words and save water. Such conversations are difficult for outsiders to follow despite their proficiency with the language. Many families have their own 'dialects' of Fa'hjad.
